## PLUMBER

This position installs, maintains, troubleshoots, and repairs plumbing and piping systems on vessels during maintenance, overhaul, and repair projects. This role supports the safe and efficient operation of shipboard systems such as potable water, wastewater, drainage, bilge, and other marine piping systems. The position requires strong trade skills, the ability to read blueprints and schematics, and comfort working in shipyard and onboard environments, including confined spaces.

### Key Responsibilities

- Install, remove, repair, and replace plumbing and piping systems aboard ships and marine vessels.
- Inspect and troubleshoot systems including potable water, black water, gray water, drainage, and associated valves, pumps, and fittings.
- Read and interpret blueprints, sketches, technical drawings, and work specifications.
- Measure, cut, fit, assemble, and secure pipe using appropriate tools and materials.
- Conduct leak checks, pressure tests, and operational testing after installation or repair.
- Perform preventive maintenance and emergency repairs to minimize downtime.
- Work with materials such as PVC, CPVC, copper nickel, steel, stainless steel, and related marine-grade components.
- Ensure all work complies with safety requirements, shipyard procedures, and applicable marine standards.
- Coordinate with supervisors and other trades such as welders, electricians, and mechanics to complete repair projects.
- Maintain clean work areas and complete required repair and inspection documentation.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

### Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent; trade school training or apprenticeship in plumbing preferred.
- Experience in plumbing, pipefitting, or marine/industrial maintenance required; shipyard or vessel repair experience preferred.
- Ability to read blueprints, schematics, and technical manuals.
- Knowledge of marine plumbing systems, valves, pumps, and fittings.

- Proficiency with hand tools, power tools, testing equipment, and safe work practices.
- Ability to work in confined spaces, at heights, and in physically demanding shipyard conditions.

- Knowledge of applicable safety standards and procedures, including lockout/tagout and confined-space requirements.
- Valid driver's license and clean driving record.
- Reliable transportation to all worksites and other locations required by the position at the start of the shift.

- Must have or be able to obtain OSHA 10 certificate.

### **Work Environment**

This position is typically based in shipyards, dry docks, and aboard vessels undergoing repair. Work may be performed indoors and outdoors in varying weather conditions and may require standing, climbing, bending, lifting, and working in tight spaces. Overtime, weekend work, and shift work may be required depending on project schedules.
